

Opioid Registry available to providers

To help providers review their patients prescribed opioids two new reports have been developed. These reports are named “Chronic Opioid Registry – I’m PCP” and “Chronic Opioid Registry – I was encounter provider” and are available in two locations:

1. Go to the provider dashboard and locate the reports under Useful Provider reports
2. Search your reports library for the report name.

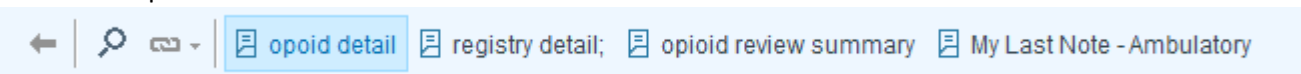
Go to the dashboard and click on one of the reports to run it may take up to several minutes to complete and will open when ready:
